



Better, faster border plans

KOMATIPOORT - At present, the border post remains the single most important constraint on the Maputo Corridor in terms of trade and the movement of people. In order to address this, the border control operational coordinating committee (BCOCC), a government body under the chair of the South African Revenue Service, has been tasked with the implementation of a one-stop border post at Lebombo/Ressano Garcia on the border of South Africa and Mozambique.

This committee is seeking the inputs of stakeholders on the proposed facility. These will be tabled in preparation for a binational meeting at which the Maputo Corridor

Logistics Initiative (MCLI) will represent the wider private sector stakeholder community.

Broad inputs from the private sector are requested as a matter of urgency, and should include, but are not limited to, the location and suggested operational mechanisms and efficiencies of a single rail clearance facility, single bus and taxi clearance facility and single freight and goods clearance facility.
