First ever three-country meeting on the Maputo Corridor

The first ever multilateral Maputo Corridor transport committee meeting has given the go-ahead for the establishment of corridor transport planning committees as envisaged in the SADC transport, communications and meteorology protocol.

The major discussion amongst the representatives of the three Maputo Corridor states – SA, Mozambique and Swaziland – was about mechanisms for implementation in the different countries. It was agreed that the relevant document would be presented to each of the heads of state for ratification – after which further meetings of the corridor countries would be convened.
