

Maputo Corridor on its way to become first choice

NELSPRUIT - Maputo Corridor Logistics Initiative (MCLI) is clearly getting its message across - as the number of hits on its website prove.

More than two million people have logged on since the site began in 2004, including nearly 730 000 international hits.

MCLI was launched in February 2004 with nine foundation members. It is a non-profit

organisation consisting of infrastructure investors, service providers and stakeholders from Mozambique, South Africa and Swaziland, who are focussed on the promotion and further development of the Maputo Development Corridor as the region's primary transport route.

Interest in the website information has steadily risen since 2004 from a few hundred visitors to

almost 23 000 in the first seven months of 2008. This year already shows an increase of 16% to August 2008 over the full year 2007.

MCLI chief executive Ms Brenda Horne says, "The statistics give a clear indication of the wide reach of our website which contains very valuable information of the corridor, our members' contact details, infrastructure rehabilitation as well as previous newsflashes

and presentations."
